Ponderosa Community Connectors

Description

A Community Connector (CC) is a Ponderosa resident who works alongside the Resident leadership Committee (RLC) to bring information and resources to Ponderosa residents. A CC will have up-to-date information on the City of Boulder project and commit to keeping neighbors informed and check in with neighbors on issues and concerns. A CC is supported by the RLC and can assist with other leadership opportunities if he/she wishes (ie- bulletin board updates, community meetings coordination).

Goals for Community Connectors

- Have accurate and up-to-date project information and useful community resources.
- Different types of people who represent the whole community.
- Coordinate with RLC to help with communication between residents and the City of Boulder (flyers, text, word of mouth).
- Create neighborhood connections that last beyond the duration of the City of Boulder project.

Responsibilities of a Community Connector

- Check your email (or phone for texts) and read community newsletters so you are up to date on project information.
- Maintain a binder of materials for residents to reference with more information (this will be provided to you).
- Attend RLC meetings and/or City meetings at Ponderosa as necessary to share questions and feedback you are hearing and learn about the project.
- Talk to you neighbors about the project, the community and help assist in getting answers to questions.
- Commitment is 3-5 hours per month.

How do I become a Community Connector?
